Management Rights.

A confirmation letter on your letterhead confirming your employment status or ownership.

Hotel Employees.

A confirmation letter on your hotel letterhead from your Manager or HR, confirming your employment status and role Alternatively, an internal ID card such as Heartist..

Travel Agents.

A confirmation letter on your agency letterhead from your Manager or HR, confirming your employment status and role. Include a copy your IATA/IATAN or CLIA membership card.

Other Industry Staff.

A confirmation letter on your business letterhead from your Manager or HR, confirming your employment status and role. Include a copy of Industry ID (Such as an ASIC card.)

Airline Staff.

A confirmation letter from your Manager or HR of your airline, confirming your employment status and role. Include a copy of your ASIC card.
